- In formal letter received by club on 19 Nov, Lusenda changed loan terms, duration reduced to 20 years, forcing board to re-consider original plan since \$ 5,600+ monthly payments are untenable for club

	- As a result of bank changing loan terms, Chris proposed post-tension concrete on Court 6 and 7, leaving Courts 10 and 11 to sit with sloped/graded packed gravel sub-surface; phased project contract plan is needed to reduce overall loan amount to something club can afford as monthly payment (~ \$ 3,500) - Discussed independent future option to pave Courts 10 and 11 with asphalt (same as Courts 4 and 5) for much less (~ \$ 60k) - Chris to go back to Rennert with updated construction plan, ideally to hear back in a couple weeks - Krishna submitted proposal request for lighting on Courts 2 and 3, await an update from him; Chris received sub-contractor lighting quote for same courts totally \$16,000; recommendation to complete sub-contractor lighting on other courts since cost is relatively low
